- ✓ Working with Children Check for Volunteers
 - Complete the online application form at <https://wwccheck.ocg.nsw.gov.au/Apply>
 - Wait for the email from Service NSW with your application number
 - Take your application number and proof of identity documents to a Service NSW office within 28 days. Volunteers DO NOT have to pay a fee for a Working With Children Check.
 - Wait for Service NSW to complete the screening process
 - Bring your Working With Children Check number and photo ID to the school office
